COME TO HOSPITAL

May survive if life saving measures are applied

EXAMPLES

- Actively Seizing
- Allergic Reactions
- Bloat (GDV)
- Collapse/ Paralysis
- Difficulty Breathing
- Excessive Bleeding
- Heat-stroke
- Open Fracture
- Poisoning
- Snake Bite
- Traffic Accident
- Urinary Blockage

CALL US

Likely to survive if care if given within hours

EXAMPLES

- Actively Vomiting
- Birthing Difficulties
- Bowel Obstruction
- Closed Fracture
- Diarrhea
- Sore Eye

SCHEDULE FOR LATER

Non life threatening conditions

EXAMPLES

- Chronic Diseases
- Lameness
- Minor Wounds
- Skin Conditions/ Abscess
- Sore Ears
- Urinary Tract Infection
